MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: CVMA TEXAS HONOR ROLL

1. Texas Honor Roll Committee
 - a. The Texas Honor Roll Committee (THRC) will comprise the State Representative (SR) - Chair, State Secretary (SSEC) - Committee Secretary (no vote), three past Texas Honor Roll Inductees, and one Full Member who has at a minimum three years in CVMA.
 - b. THRC will be selected annually at the CVMA Texas State Meeting.
 - c. THRC, by a unanimous vote, may recommend removal of Texas Honor Roll Inductee to the SR. The basis for removal will be consistent with the values of the CVMA and must be well documented and substantiated.
 - d. The criterion and evaluation may be reviewed and edited on an annual basis as determined by the THRC.
2. Texas Honor Roll Nominations and Submissions
 - a. Only one nomination per Chapter may be submitted.
 - b. The State Executive Board (SEB) may opt to submit a single Full Member or Support Member nominee from CVMA TX.
 - c. Must be a member of CVMA for a minimum of three years, and a member of CVMA TX for at least one year.
 - d. Must have maintained "IN GOOD STANDING" for the duration of the nominee's membership.
 - e. Must have at least one CVMA TX Annual State Meeting within the three preceding years, and one Sanctioned Event listed on 201 for each of the three preceding years.
 - f. Submissions will use a standard paragraph format, and must be submitted to the SSEC no later than July 31st at 2359 each year. See Appendix A.
3. Texas Honor Roll Evaluation and Induction
 - a. THRC will utilize a point-based evaluation system.
 - b. Nominees receiving 500 points under the evaluation system will be automatically added to the Texas Honor Roll. If there are four nominees that receive 500 points, no other nominees will be added to the Texas Honor Roll for that year.
 - c. Nominees with the highest points will be inducted, and those that are not inducted into the Texas Honor Roll may be resubmitted the following year for review.
 - d. The final approval authority for induction into the Texas Honor Roll will be the SR.

Appendix A
Texas Honor Roll Submissions

- I. **CVMA Service (200 points max)**
 - A. **Event Attendance (100 points possible)**
 - 1. CVMA Sanctioned Event: 1 point each
 - 2. CVMA Texas State Meeting: 5 points. each
 - 3. CVMA Region 5 Rally: 10 points. each
 - 4. CVMA National Meeting: 15 points. each.
 - B. **CVMA Officer Service (100 points possible)**
 - 1. Chapter Appointed Officer: 1 point per year
 - 2. Chapter Executive Board (CEB): 2 points per year
 - 3. State Executive Board (SEB): 4 points per year
 - 4. Region Representative: 6 points per year
 - 5. National Board of Directors (NBOD): 10 points per year

- II. **Actions of Merit (175 points max)**
 - A. **Riding Programs (50 points possible)**
 - 1. Texas 23 Rider Program: 50 points
 - 2. CVMA Long Range Riding Platoon (LRRP)
 - a) Inner-State: 10 points
 - b) Tri-State: 15 points
 - c) Finish the Mission: 20 points
 - d) Grand Slam: 50 points
 - B. **Volunteer Service (50 points possible)**
 - 1. One point per hour will be awarded for the following, but are not limited to:
 - a) Funerals and/or processions
 - b) Welcome home/send offs
 - c) Promotion, retirement, and military graduations
 - d) Veteran community service
 - C. **Distinguishable Actions (75 points possible)**
 - 1. Distinguishable Actions will be evaluated by each member of the THRC, and present a points value ranging from 1 - 50. The points will be averaged and applied towards the nominee's total points.
 - 2. Examples of Distinguishable Actions may be, but not limited to:
 - a) Providing long term care and support to a CVMA Member and/or Veteran in need.
 - b) Providing physical or financial assistance to a CVMA Member and/or Veteran in need.

- III. **CVMA Contributions (125 points max) - Examples of contributions may be, but are not limited to:**
 - A. **Veterans Community Service/Contributions: Initiatives developed/led by nominee (5 pts. each)**
 - B. **Organizational Achievements**
 - 1. Chapter: Initiatives developed/led by nominee (15 pts. each)
 - 2. State: Initiatives developed/led by nominee (10 pts. each)
 - 3. Regional/National: Initiatives developed/led by nominee (5 pts. each)
